RESIDENT TESTIMONY

My name is Tonya Carroll. I was born in Anniston. Alabama, but I have lived in Panama City my whole life. Growing up was fine, but then I found myself alone. I was a teenager the first time I used drugs and alcohol. Years of addiction led to loneliness and poverty, which eventually caused me to end up in jail and then prison.

While in Lifeline at the Bay County Jail, I heard about Humble House, where Rachel Duvall was teaching God's Word. Humble House has taught me about the unconditional love of God, the importance of forgiveness, and the value of a personal relationship with Jesus. I learned about the guidance provided by the Bible, the significance of community, and the responsibility to live a life that reflects Christian values, such as kindness, compassion, and service to others.

I refuse to be defined by my mistakes. God has taught me to depend on Him as my provider, to trust in His plan, and to develop greater gratitude. I've learned to cultivate a spirit of generosity and prioritize spiritual wealth over material possessions. Through waiting, God has shown me the importance of His presence, His plans, renewed trust, stillness, silence, and rest.




